

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COATESVILLE, COUNTY OF CHESTER AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE 2010 ADOPTED MUNICIPAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING SPECIFIC SUMS ESTIMATED TO BE REQUIRED FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSE OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT AS THEREIN SET FORTH, FOR THE YEAR 2010

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Coatesville, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1.

For the expenses of the City for the year 2010, the following amounts are hereby appropriated from the revenues available for the year for the departments, bureaus and specific purposes set forth as follows:


All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.




