

**ORDINANCE**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 218-11 OF THE CITY OF COATESVILLE’S PARKING CODE TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON SOUTH THIRD AVENUE FROM NORTH OF THE DRIVEWAY ACCESSING 149 SOUTH THIRD AVENUE SOUTH TO THE INTERSECTION WITH OAK STREET ON THE EASTERN SIDE OF THE STREET**

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville is a Third Class City located in Chester County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville has recently received numerous complaints of parking problems on South Third Avenue which have created access problems for the homeowner at 149 South Third Avenue, the property located on the northeast corner of the intersection of South Third Avenue and Oak Street in the City of Coatesville; and

WHEREAS, in order to alleviate this problem, and in view of the upward grade of South Third Avenue and the close proximity to the corner (and attendant limited visibility for vehicles traveling uphill and south on South Third Avenue), the Chief of Police has recommended that a sign be placed just north of the access driveway to 149 South Third Avenue and that the eastern side of South Third Avenue, from the location of this sign to the corner of South Third Avenue and Oak Street be identified as “no parking/parking prohibited”.

WHEREAS, action to address this problem requires an amendment to the City’s Parking regulations found at Chapter 218 of the City Code, governing Vehicles and Traffic, and in particular, an amendment to Section 218-11 “Schedule of Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets” to identify this location as a “no parking” area.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the City of Coatesville does hereby amend Section 218-11 of the City Code governing “Schedule of Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets” to add the following new location set forth as follows:

<b>Street</b>	<b>Sides</b>	<b>Location</b>
“Third Avenue, South	East	From north of existing driveway to 149 S. Third Avenue south to intersection at Oak Street <sup>1</sup> ”


<sup>1</sup> Appropriate signage and other markings necessary to notify the public of the prohibition against parking shall be installed at this location.

All other terms of the City Code governing parking, including, without limitation, the procedures addressing violations and enforcement, shall remain in full force and effect.

If any portion of the Ordinance shall be determined to be unconstitutional, illegal or unenforceable, then the portion and only that portion of this Ordinance, which is deemed to be unconstitutional, illegal or unenforceable, shall be severed from the remainder of this Ordinance and all other terms thereof shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after publication following final adoption in accordance with the City Charter and the Third-Class City Code.
