

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 218 OF THE CITY CODE GOVERNING PARKING TO DELETE A PORTION OF CHAPTER 218-22. A TO REMOVE THE TWO-HOUR PARKING LIMIT ON THE NORTH SIDE OF LINCOLN HIGHWAY WEST BETWEEN THE BRANDYWINE RAILROAD TO THE WESTERN PROPERTY LINE OF PROPERTY IDENTIFIED AS THE G.O.CARLSON TRACT AND TO AMEND SECTION 218-19 GOVERNING PROHIBITIONS OF PARKING AT CERTAIN TIMES SO AS TO PROHIBIT PARKING FROM 8:00 P.M. TO 8:00 A.M. AT THIS SAME LOCATION (AND PERMIT FREE PARKING AT THIS LOCATION FROM 8:00 A.M. TO 8:00 P.M.)

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville is a Third Class City located in Chester County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the City has recently opened its River Walk located on the west of the Brandywine Creek and requiring the need of free parking in the adjacent area on the north side of Lincoln Highway during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. but which should be restricted against parking from 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 218-22 of the City Code previously regulated this portion of the North side of Lincoln Highway and restricted it to two (2) hour parking and this restriction needs to be removed and the aforementioned provisions put in place under Section 218-19 of the City Code.

WHEREAS, in order to effectuate such regulation, an amendment to the Current Ordinance and City Code is required;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the City of Coatesville does hereby Amend Chapter 218 of the City Code as follows:

1. The portion of Section 218-19 "Schedule Of Parking Time Limited At All Times On Certain Streets" subsection A. "Two-hour parking limit" is amended by the deletion of the following:

"North Lincoln Highway, West between Brandywine Railroad tracks and West property line of G.O. Carlson, Monday through Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m."

2. The portion of Section 218-19 "Schedule Of Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours On Certain Streets" is amended by the addition of the following:

“North Lincoln Highway, West between Brandywine Railroad tracks and West property line of G.O. Carlson Tract (Tax Parcel Nos. 16-5-16 and 16-5-16.1), Monday through Sunday from 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. (free parking 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.).”

3. All other terms of the City Code governing parking, including, without limitation, the procedures addressing violations and enforcement, shall remain in full force and effect.

4. If any portion of the Ordinance shall be determined to be unconstitutional, illegal or unenforceable, then the portion and only that portion of this Ordinance, which is deemed to be unconstitutional, illegal or unenforceable, shall be severed from the remainder of this Ordinance and all other terms thereof shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after publication following final adoption in accordance with the City Charter and the Third-Class City Code.
