

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 218 OF THE CITY CODE GOVERNING PARKING TO REMOVE THE NO-PARKING RESTRICTIONS OF CHAPTER 218-11 ON SOUTH SIDE ONLY OF OAK STREET BETWEEN ROSEMONT AVENUE AND FOURTH AVENUE SOUTH SO AS TO ALLOW EXTRA PARKING FOR RESIDENTS' PUBLIC PARKING (AND TO PROVIDE NO-PARKING IN THIS SAME AREA ON THURSDAYS FROM 12:00 P.M. TO 2:30 P.M. IN CHAPTER 218-19 TO PERMIT STREET SWEEPING).

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville is a Third Class City located in Chester County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Cambria Terrace subdivision in the City Coatesville has an insufficiency of parking for the residents of Community Lane and Colina Lane which and can be alleviated by lifting the parking restrictions on the south side of Oak Street between Rosemont Avenue and South Fourth Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 218-11 of the City Code currently prohibits parking on both sides of Oak Street between Rosemont Avenue and South Fourth Avenue, but there is room for additional parking by lifting the restriction against parking on the south side of this section of Oak Street for public parking; and

WHEREAS, in lifting this parking restriction, the City must adhere to the street sweeping which is conducted on Oak Street on Thursdays from 12:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. and for which parking is temporarily restricted in other areas of Oak Street under Chapter 218-19 of the City Code.

WHEREAS, in order to effectuate such regulation, an amendment to the current Ordinance and City Code is required;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the City of Coatesville does hereby Amend Chapter 218 of the City Code as follows:

1. A portion of Section 218-11 "Schedule Of Parking Prohibited at All Times On Certain Streets" is amended under the heading "Oak Street" by the deletion of the word "Both" and replacing it with the word "North" thereby making Section 218-11 relating to Oak Street read as follows:

" Oak Street North Between Rosemont Avenue and Fourth Avenue, South"

2. The portion of Section 218-19 "Schedule Of Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours On Certain Streets" shall be amended under the section relating to "Oak Street"

shall by adding an additional "Location" identified as "From South Fourth Avenue to Rosemont Avenue" and adding an additional reference to "Hours" by stating thereafter, "Thursdays from 12:00 noon to 2:30 p.m."

3. All other terms of the City Code governing parking, including, without limitation, the procedures addressing violations and enforcement, shall remain in full force and effect.

4. If any portion of the Ordinance shall be determined to be unconstitutional, illegal or unenforceable, then the portion and only that portion of this Ordinance, which is deemed to be unconstitutional, illegal or unenforceable, shall be severed from the remainder of this Ordinance and all other terms thereof shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after publication following final adoption in accordance with the City Charter and the Third-Class City Code.
