

**RESOLUTION No. 2009-05**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COATESVILLE, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF 1000 MOTION DETECTOR LIGHTS**

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville is a chartered Third Class City in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (hereinafter the "City"); and,

WHEREAS,, arson is a serious crime that affects all people and can be stopped when citizens realize the physical and emotional damage suffered by arson victims; and

WHEREAS, recent disasters have demonstrated that arson is a serious crime that affects all people and can be stopped when citizens realize the toll arson takes on communities; and


WHEREAS, arson is frequently used as an act of terrorism and brutality; and

WHEREAS, arsonists work in isolation and prefer poorly lit areas, good outdoor lighting can be an effective deterrent; and.



ADOPTED as a Resolution this 26<sup>th</sup> day of January 2009, effective immediately.


