**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF COATESVILLE TO SELL OR DISPOSE OF MUNICIPAL PERSONAL PROPERTY BY INTERNET AUCTION**

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville is a Home Rule Charter Third Class City in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville may own personal property, including motor vehicles acquired for the use of municipal officers and departments, and road machinery, equipment, tools, or supplies, which are not needed for public use, or are obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired; and

WHEREAS, it is determined that personal property owned by the City which no longer serves a useful municipal purpose may be sold by internet auction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville has the capability of contracting with a private internet-based auction system to conduct the internet auction; and

WHEREAS, this resolution expresses Council's intent to sell unneeded, obsolete and unfit vehicles by internet auction; and

WHEREAS, the proceeds from the sale of such property shall be deposited in the General Fund.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Coatesville hereby resolved by authority of the same:

Section 1: That the City Administration is authorized to sell obsolete or unfit municipal vehicles by internet auction in the year 2010 (See the attached Schedule "A");

Section 2: The auction shall be advertised in a local newspaper as required by law;

Section 3: The Director of each department may establish a minimum price that will be accepted for the obsolete vehicles;

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Council of the City of Coatesville has adopted and enacted this Resolution this 11<sup>th</sup> day of January 2010.


