


RESOLUTION 2010-26

WHEREAS, the Coatesville Codes Department has been working with the Coatesville Weed and Seed Community Policing Sub-committee for assistance in identifying and documenting code violations within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Coatesville Code Volunteer Program has been formed through the Codes Department consisting of local, area citizens for the purpose of identifying and reporting violations of the "Top 7" codes issues after proper training from the Codes Department; and

WHEREAS, the Coatesville Code Volunteers have requested that the City Council officially recognize the efforts of these citizens.


