

RESOLUTION No. 2011-18

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COATESVILLE, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPOINTING TAX COLLECTION COMMITTEE DELEGATE

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville is a Third Class City operating under a Home Rule Charter in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and


WHEREAS, Act 32 § 505(b) requires the governing bodies of school districts, townships, boroughs, and cities to appoint one voting delegate and one or more alternate delegates to be their Tax Collection Committee (TCC) representatives. The purpose of this resolution is to appoint the required delegates. The appointed individuals have consented to appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council for the City of Coatesville hereby appoints the following individuals as TCC delegates for the City of Coatesville:

1. Primary voting delegate: Gary Rawlings
2. First alternate voting delegate: Stacy BJORHUS
3. Second alternate voting delegate: Kirby Hudson
4. If the primary voting delegate cannot be present for a TCC meeting, the first alternate voting delegate shall be the representative at the TCC meeting. If both the primary voting delegate and the first alternate voting delegate cannot be present for a TCC meeting, the second alternate voting delegate shall be the representative at the TCC meeting.
5. These appointments are effective immediately and shall continue until successors are appointed. Delegates shall be appointed each year in November or December or as soon thereafter as possible. All delegates shall serve at the pleasure of this governing body and may be removed at any time.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, the Council of the City of Coatesville hereby authorizes the execution and attestation of this resolution.


