

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COATESVILLE, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SUPPORTING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO CHESTER COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS FOR THE NATIONAL VELODROME CENTER INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Coatesville is pursuing development of a proposed National Velodrome Center for real estate known as the "Flats"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville desires to support the Redevelopment Authority and participate in the Chester County Department of Community Development Application for Community Revitalization Program Grant Funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville is the eligible applicant for Community revitalization Program Grant Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City has been informed that it has authority to confirm the Application or, in the alternative, to withdraw the Application; and

WHEREAS, previously by Resolution No. 2011-21 executed on July 25, 2011, the City of Coatesville adopted a Resolution in support of the Redevelopment Authority's request that it file a Community Revitalization Program Grant application on behalf of the Redevelopment Authority; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville has already had a public hearing on this matter in support thereof on July 25, 2011 and still supports the project and is requesting and will be receiving public written comments prior to formal application on or by March 23, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority has again respectfully requested for the City of Coatesville, as the eligible applicant, to file a Community Revitalization Program Grant Application on behalf of the Redevelopment Authority; and

WHEREAS, in support of the project, it was mentioned in the Solicitor's Presentation on March 12, 2012 that the City Manager would be filing the grant application as referenced herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Coatesville;

- a) To support and participate with the Redevelopment Authority in the filing of a grant application by the City of Coatesville for Community Revitalization Program Funding. The grant request will be submitted to the Chester County Department of Community Development.
- b) The City of Coatesville confirms its authorization of Gary Rawlings, City Manager, to execute and file the appropriate forms with the Chester County Department of Community Development.
