

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COATESVILLE, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SUPPORTING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE CHESTER COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, FOR THE 2016 CHESTER COUNTY COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS, FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CITY OF COATESVILLE CONSISTING OF THE CORRECTION AND ALIGNMENT OF THROUGH LANES AT THE INTERSECTION OF ROUTES 30, 82, AND FIRST AVENUE FOR VEHICLE EFFICIENCY AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY.

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville is pursuing a supplemental 2016 Community Revitalization Program (CRP) Grant for improvements related to the projected titled Lincoln Highway & 1st Avenue Intersection Improvements, including lane alignment northbound from First Avenue to Route 82 at Route 30, the addition of north and south bound left turn lanes for traffic movement, pedestrian improvements, and signal optimization;

WHEREAS, the City has advertised a public hearing to be held on April 11, 2016 at 7:30 PM prior to the City Council meeting to obtain public comments on such application; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville is in support of the aforementioned CRP Grant Application and passes this Resolution to authorize the City Manager, and any other relevant and necessary representatives of the City, including the City Council President, to sign all necessary documents for the Grant Application as referenced previously.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Coatesville, after public meetings and the consideration of public comments, as follows:

- a) The Council for the City of Coatesville supports the Grant Application to the Chester County Department of Community Development for a 2016 Community Revitalization Program Grant for improvements defined in the previous CRP Scope for Lincoln Highway & 1st Avenue Intersection Improvements and requests that the Grant Application be submitted to the Chester County Department of Community Development.
- b) The Council for the City of Coatesville confirms that, Michael Trio, City Manager, (and any other relevant and necessary City representatives, including the City Council President) are authorized to execute and file the appropriate forms with the Chester County Department of Community Development for the grant as referenced in this resolution.
