**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COATESVILLE, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SUPPORTING A GRANT APPLICATION WITH CHESTER COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR THE 2017 CDBG – COATESVILLE STREET AND TRAIN STATION RENOVATIONS - GRANT FUNDS (UP TO \$370,000.00) FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CITY OF COATESVILLE RELATING TO THE TRAIN STATION LOCATED AT THE CORNER OF THIRD AVENUE AND FLEETWOOD STREET AND INFRASTRUCTURE RENOVATIONS ALONG THIRD AVENUE FROM LINCOLN HIGHWAY TO ASH PARK**

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville is pursuing a grant for improvements relative to the train station located at the corner of Third Avenue and Fleetwood Street and infrastructure renovations along Third Avenue from Lincoln Highway to Ash Park in the maximum amount of \$370,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed the proposed Chester County Contract for Services related to the aforementioned CDBG Grant; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville in support of this project passes this Resolution to authorize the City Manager, and any other relevant and necessary representatives of the City, including the City Engineer, to sign all necessary documents for the Grant as referenced previously.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Coatesville, as follows:

- a) The City Council of the City of Coatesville supports the Grant with the Chester County Department of Community Development for a 2017 CDBG Grant of up to Three Hundred and Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$370,000.00) for improvements relative to the train station located at the corner of Third Avenue and Fleetwood Street and infrastructure renovations along Third Avenue from Lincoln Highway to Ash Park
- b) The City Council confirms that the City Manager, Michael T. Trio (and any other relevant and necessary City representatives, including the City Engineer) are authorized to execute and file the appropriate forms with the Chester County Department of Community Development for the grant as referenced in this resolution.
