

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COATESVILLE, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF COATESVILLE TO APPLY FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE USDA FARMERS MARKET PROMOTION PROGRAM OF APPROXIMATELY \$250,000 WITH A SERVICES IN-KIND MATCH COMPONENT AND CASH MATCH COMPONENT, AND PERMITTING THE ASSISTANT CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED LETTER OF VERIFICATION FOR COST SHARE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coatesville (the “City”) is a Home Rule Municipality operating by means of a home rule charter and the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, in collaboration with 2nd Century Alliance, Growing Roots, and AgConnect, the City formally expresses its support for and intent to apply for a grant of approximately \$250,000 through the USDA Farmers Market Promotion Program; and


WHEREAS, as part of the application process for the USDA Farmers Market Promotion Program grant, the City is required to execute both a Resolution and a Letter of Verification for Cost Share.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Coatesville, Chester County, Pennsylvania, that the Council authorizes:

- 1) The City to apply for the USDA Farmers Market Promotion Program grant.
- 2) The Assistant City Manager to execute the Letter of Verification for Cost Share in the form attached hereto as Exhibit “A.”
- 3) The City to provide services in-kind in the amount of \$21,390 as a match component and up to \$12,000 as a cash match for a total of \$33,390 to the grant through the USDA Farmers Market Promotion Program.
